- Problend G15 Sanded Colour Grout is only suitable for joints from 2mm to 15mm.
- Problend G15 Sanded Colour Grout contains sand and should be tested on soft natural stones and tiles prior to use.
- Do not apply in temperature below 5°C and above 35°C.
- Ensure substrate have correct falls to waste, are free from resdual moisture, and dry.
- Effloresence & Shade variation is beyond the control of the manufacturer and is influenced by the climate and application technique.
- Colour may be different from samples. Application, climate, and environment may all have an impact on the final result and colour of the grout.
- Test for suitabilty of use with natural stones prior to
- G15 is not suitable for submerged applications.
- Ensure substrate deflection standard are achieved with all tiling applications.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE QUALITY / PRE-TREATMENT

Ensure adhesive is dry and hard and free from excess residual moisture.

Check to ensure joints are of even depth and free from excess adhesive to assist in colour unformity. Clean tiles and joint to be free from dust and othe comtaminates.

On highly porous tiles it may be necessary to pre dampen the joint prior to application.

Pourous stone, terracotta may require sealer prior to application to avoid staining.

Remove all spacers lugs prior to application.

MIXING

Add a measure ammount of clean cool water into a mixing container and slowly add the Problend G15 Sanded Colour Grout while stirring with a slow speed drill (max 300RPM). Mix to a smooth uniform lump free consistency and allow to mixture to stand "slake" for 5 minutes. Then re-stirr prior to use without adding any addition water.

Do not add addition water to previously mixed grout.

APPLICATION

Tiles shall be fixed in accordance to AS3958.1:2007 Ensure Adhesive is dry and adequately cured and free from residual moisture prior to application.

Apply the grout with a grout float ensuring the grout is worked well into the joint to ensure full joints.

Discard any stiffen / old grout, do not re-mix by adding water.

Do not spread more grout that cant be cleaned within 30 minutes.

Allow the grout to lightly firm prior to cleaning. Clean joints with clean water and a semi-dry sponge to avoid excess water.

Cleaning joints with the sponge in a diagonal motion to the joint.

Periodically change water to minimise grout haze. Allow grout to full harden prior to removing any residual grout haze.

Residual minor haze can be removed with a microfibre cloth the next day.

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT

Tools and equipement can be cleaned with water with the grout is still wet.
